October 27 – "The Saints and Us: Friends Forever" During this session, we will celebrate the saints as our friends and faithful followers of Christ with God forever, remember those who have gone before us in faith and learn the difference between the Feast of All Saints and the Feast of All Souls.

**November 24 – "Jesus is Coming!"** During this Advent Gathering, we will explore the role of a prophet in the lives of God's people in order to prepare to celebrate the season of Advent more meaningfully in our families.
